Alpha is for:

Helping one another. The small groups give you a chance to discuss issues raised during the talks.

Ask anything. *Alpha* is a place where no question is seen as too simple or too hostile.

Who is Alpha For?

Alpha is for everyone! It's especially geared toward:

- People interested in investigating Christianity
- Newcomers to the church
- New Christians
- Couples preparing for marriage
- Christians who want to brush up on the basics

What Happens at Alpha?

There is a series of talks on topics such as:

- Who is Jesus?
- Why Did Jesus Die?
- Why and How should I Read the Bible?
- Why and How Do I Pray?
- What About the Holy Spirit?
- How Can I Overcome Evil?
- Why and How Should I Tell Others?
- Does God Heal Today?
- What About the Church?

After each talk a small group time is held for everyone to discuss the topic for the night. This gives an opportunity to get to know each other and to learn together.
