Campaign Overview

Celebration Goal: \$800,000

This amount will put us in position, in light of our assets and potential sources of income, to begin the project. It will mean carrying some debt after the 3-year campaign in order to complete the project.

Ultimate Goal: \$1,200,000

Reaching \$1.2 million in pledges, with our other current assets, will allow us to complete the project without any debt after the campaign is completed.

Youth group programs and Scouts

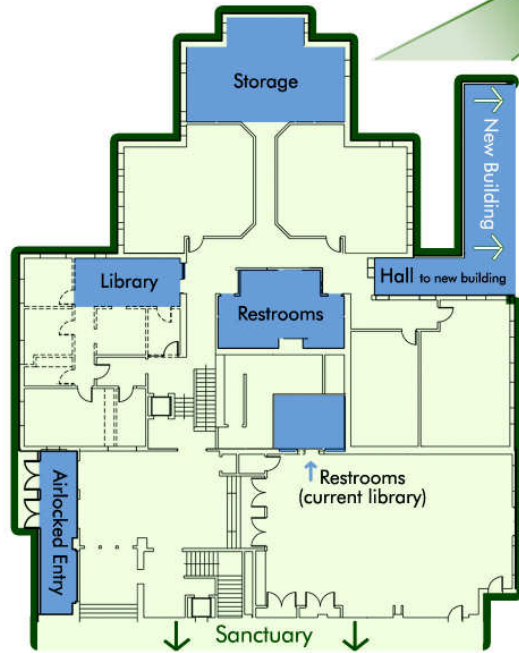

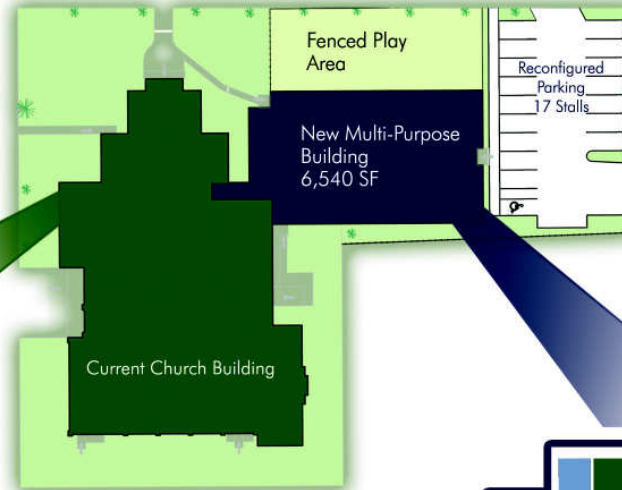

Millwood Church Campus (New building in blue)

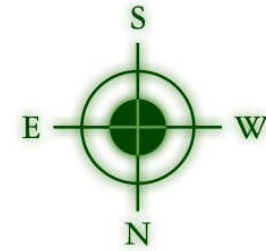


Main Campus Renovations

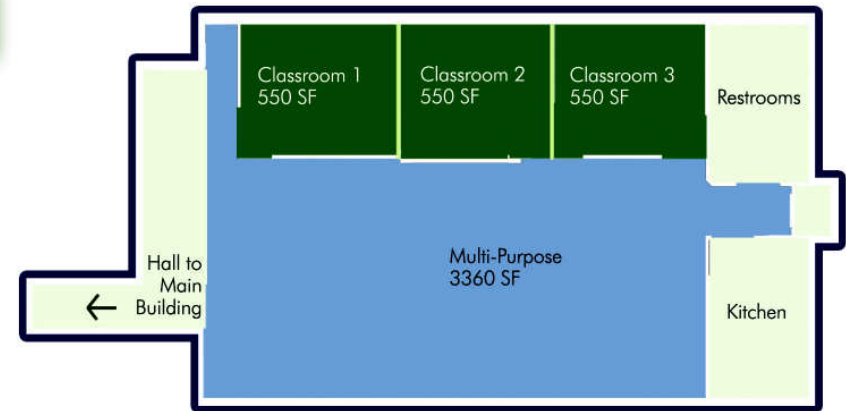
- ♦ Lower level below offices and chapel, plus main entry and former library

New Building Detail



Project List

Major Improvements to current building: \$140,000

- ♦ Lower South Wing (area underneath offices): add bathrooms, relocate library, expand lower conference room
- ♦ Sanctuary: Air condition sanctuary, update sound system, new energy-efficient lighting
- ♦ Main Entrance Area: Add front vestibule (to provide airlock)
- ♦ Current Library Area: convert to restrooms (library will be relocated)
- ♦ Offices: reconfigure to put all staff on upper floor
- ♦ New carpeting throughout

Proposed New Multi-Purpose Building: \$1,440,000

- ♦ Single level, 6,540 square feet, connected to main building
- ♦ Three classrooms, kitchen, restrooms, 3300 square foot multi-purpose room
